TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
October 23, 2008 - SPECIAL CLOSED SESSION

The Board of Commissioners of Transylvania County met in special session on Thursday, October 23, 2008 at 6:30 p.m. in the Administration Building Conference Room.
