MINUTES TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS December 9, 2010 – SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of Transylvania County met in special session on Thursday, December 9, 2010 at 7:00 a.m. in the Administration Building Conference Room. The special meeting was called for the sole purpose of holding a closed session in accordance with North Carolina General Statute 143-318.11 (a) (5) to establish, or to instruct staff concerning the position to be taken on behalf of the public body in negotiating the price or other material terms for the acquisition of real property.

Commissioners present were Larry Chapman, Jason Chappell, Chairman Mike Hawkins, Daryle Hogsed, and Vice-Chairman Kelvin Phillips. Also present were County Manager Artie Wilson, Finance Director Gay Poor, County Attorney Curtis Potter, and Clerk to the Board Trisha Hogan.

CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME
