<u>POSITION</u>: <u>SALARY GRADE</u>: <u>STATUS</u>: Income Maintenance Administrator I 119 (\$ 55,352.24 - \$85,795.98) Permanent, full-time

Duties: This position will provide programmatic management and administrative supervision for the agency including Work First, Work First Emergency Assistance, Adult and Family & Children's Medicaid, Special Assistance to Adults, Food and Nutrition, Low Income Energy Assistance, Child Care Subsidy, Program Integrity, and Income Maintenance Clerical staff. This includes Income Maintenance Supervisor II positions. Work in the units involves the determination and redetermination of client eligibility for all of the public assistance programs. This position will be responsible for training and monitoring to ensure state mandated performance measures are being achieved. This position will work with Supervisors and Director to identify agency needs, objectives and strategies. Responsibilities may include involvement in the community, assessment of program needs, unit training and organization, personnel functions, compiling data, conducting case reviews and audits.

<u>Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities</u>: Considerable knowledge of public assistance programs. Considerable knowledge of needs and problems of disadvantaged persons. Ability to instruct, direct, provide leadership and supervise lower level supervisors. Ability to maintain satisfactory working relationship with co-workers, clients, advocacy groups, officials of other agencies and the public. Excellent communication skills are needed to provide training, write memos, letters, reports, etc. and to interact with persons of all social, economic and educational backgrounds. Ability to implement a structured planning process focusing on short and long range factors.
