### **FIXING** Transylvania Schools

August 2024

- > ALL PROJECTS FUNDED As identified by the building assessment and Joint BOC-BOE Education Capital Work Group for Step One: Investment (SOI) grouped into contract scopes. Five year capital planning is a best practice identified by the UNC School of Government and in NCGS 115C-462.2.
- > Two Bond Sales will be Needed to leverage \$68 million. The LGC expects projects funded to be reasonable to complete listed in three years. \$50.8 million sale set for Oct 2024 meaning funding in hand for contract signing Nov 2024. Second sale in 2028.
- > Cash funding in GREEN indicates cash is currently available to move forward when BOE chooses to do so in the FY 25-30 plan. Cash not in green indicates future cash allocation
- > Annual School Capital Funding for FFE (desks, band/athletic equip), Vehicles and Repair Funds will continue to be allocated annually to TCS. Approx. \$1 million annually last 5 years
